Annapolis Cravings - 18 seats available June 11, 2025 Deposit - \$50pp Cost - \$205pp

Enjoy a tour of historic Annapolis and tour the US Naval Academy including the historical and beautiful Beaux Arts building, the Main Chapel, the crypt of John Paul Jones and the USNA Museum. Enjoy an afternoon Tea at the Naval Academy Club. End the day with a cruise on the Harbor Queen of Annapolis Bay. Photo ID required for this trip.

LEGISLATIVE REPORT:

As of Jan. 31, 2025, our PRE-ACT 9 retirees needed \$176.58 to purchase what cost \$100 on July 1, 2002, the effective date of the last COLA. Also, our POST-ACT 9 retirees who retired between July 1, 2002, and June of 2007 needed between \$152.47 and \$176.58 to purchase what cost \$100 the day they retired. These retirees have lost at least half of the purchasing power they had when they retired. It looks like many of Post-Act retirees also need a COLA. PASR's State L/PEC Committee (AKA Legislative Committee) also supports a COLA for Post Act-9 retirees.

If the effective date of HB 1416 was July 1, 2023, and the bill had passed in July of 2023, Pre-Act 9 retirees would have needed \$169.60 to purchase what cost \$100 since their last COLA. But the loss of purchasing power since July 1, 2023, has grown an additional 6.98% and as of Jan. 31, 2025, Pre-Act 9 retirees now need \$176.58 to purchase what cost \$100 since their last COLA. Therefore, In the opinion of this writer, any new COLA bill needs to reflect an upgrade in payout percentages (an upgrade of 3.5% would be about right) from the payout percentages listed in HB 1416. Members attending the February meeting of PASR's State L/PEC Committee agreed with this position and agreed that PASR's state lobbyists are notified of said position.


