### **LEGISLATIVE REPORT:**

#### SITUATION I - COLA PROPOSAL

The current COLA proposal for PA retired school employees would range from 15% to 24 1/2%, depending on the year of retirement - it excludes retirees who retired after July 1, 2001 because they were included in Act 9. However, due to inflation since January 2002, item x costing \$100 in Jan 2002 now costs \$174.15. (https://www.bls.gov/data/inflation\_calculator.htm)

So, if the current COLA proposal becomes law the amount received would depend on your year of retirement. Persons retiring between July 2, 2000, through July 1, 2001 would get \$115. Persons who retired before July 2, 1982 would get the \$124.50.

One may ask, "Does this COLA proposal really help anybody pay their bills?" One may view that the current COLA proposal as being similar to a previously opened COLA beverage left in the refrigerator. Both have gone flat.

Many pre-Act 9 retirees remember that the design of the last two COLA's of 1998 and 2002 was adopted with the following policy intent: Ensuring that all PSERS annuitants be provided an increase of an amount that replaced, at a minimum, one-half of the loss of purchasing power experienced through inflation since the member's year of retirement.

## SITUATION 2 - PA LEGISLATOR'S COLA

The last three consecutive COLAs for our legislators were annual, automatic and totaled over 16.64%. Legislators began receiving their latest COLA in their Dec. 2023 paychecks. Many would see the contrast between the two situations just mentioned as (politely put) mind boggling!

#### **CONCLUSION**

We are encouraged to press onward for a COLA. With resolve and confidence may we help our legislators see that the COLA needed is one that shows real sensitivity to the loss of buying power since 2002.
