The Great Gatsby on Broadway – 25 seats available April 10, 2025 Deposit - \$150pp Cost - \$265pp

LAURETTA WOODSON AWARD

The Lauretta Woodson Award was presented to James Statler, a dedicated technology education teacher in the Mechanicsburg Area School District.

With Jim's leadership in the classroom his students have manufactured many products (Adirondack chairs, corn hole boards, end tables, coffee tables) that have been donated to the Wildcat Foundation to raise funds for the Foundation. They have erected sheds for Soldiers and Sailors Memorial Park in Mechanicsburg and constructed Little Free Libraries for around the community.

An automated street crossing sign for Mechanicsburg Borough was built by the students and entered the PA Governor's STEM competition. The students received an Honorable Mention. His students have won many awards at the Technology Students Association regional and state competitions in which Jim is the advisor.

Jim also leads a team of students to design and construct the musical sets for Mechanicsburg High School's Spring Musicals.
