
Tuesday, May 12, 2026

Thursday, May 14, 2026

Enjoy breakfast before we depart for Plains GA—home of President Jimmy Carter. Here you will see his boyhood home, the Plains High School Museum and the Train Depot. Learn all about the Carter's early lives and Presidency. Later you depart for Warm Springs to enjoy lunch at the Bullock House before your visit to President Franklin Roosevelt's Little White House. From his visit in 1924, Roosevelt returned every year, except 1942, to use the therapeutic waters at Warm Springs. As President-elect, during the Depression winter of 1932-33, he went twice to Warm Springs, staying in his new house. Finished in 1932, the Little White House is a modest, six room, one-story cottage. Return to your hotel tonight, you have dinner either at the Drury Kickback (included) or visit one of several restaurants within walking distance (on your own). (B, L, KB)

Friday, May 15, 2026

After breakfast at the hotel, we meet our guide for a day in Atlanta .Your guide will share all of Atlanta's Civil Rights history and so much more. You will visit Martin Luther King National Historic Site and the National Center for Civil and Human Rights. Today you will enjoy a local BBQ luncheon and visit a local food hall for dinner “on your own”. (B,L)

Saturday, May 16, 2026

Following breakfast at the hotel you will check out and depart towards home. Today we will stop and visit the Sweetwater Valley Farms in Philadelphia, TN, where you will enjoy a farm tour and lunch made with farm fresh products. You'll overnight in Abingdon Va at the Hampton Inn and enjoy a local dinner tonight. (B, L D)

Sunday, May 17, 2026

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before checking out. Today you will enjoy a moving tour of the National D-Day Memorial before departing for home with rest and meal stops en route, “on your own” (B) 5PM Approximate arrival back.
